Equipment location test based on NYS part 800 checklist. - Provide copy of checklist,

- Stair chair skills
- Scoop stretcher use
- Reeves use
- Stretcher operations for both 501 & 502, including moving the track and making the cot.
- Use of address book and grid map to find address. Hagstrom for Mutual aid.
- proficiency w/ gps
- Log roll/basic spinal immobilization/holding manual stabilization
- Know to get blocks/check straps(bring tape if missing) when getting long board.
- Difference b/w the two portable radios (uhf for MCI vs NCPD)
- Basic radio operations-channel selection, which radio talks to who (familiarization, not use)
- Call-in system functionality, make sure person has copy of address book if they get paged to scene.
- Backing up rig. Training session for this purpose
- Oxygen training, including setting up ambu bag
- Assemble collar, including overview of how to measure
- identify pcr box
- Identify key differences in equipment locations for 501 vs 502 - provide printed list.
- Some discussion of call scene dynamics. Our role, NCPD role, Medic role, FD role
- Everyone is responsible for safety-if you see something, say something.
- Common lingo/abbreviations. Ex: bus, rig, gurney, stretcher, roller gauze, cling bandage, BVM, 60 control, NCPD, backboard/long board, cravat/ triangular bandage.
